The Fearsome Foreskin finished 2026 at the bottom of the World of Warcraft division, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: six major reaches against zero steals, a combination that is less a strategy than a confession. The most damning entry is Jacory Croskey-Merritt, projected RB40, taken five and a half rounds before his ADP suggested anyone else wanted him, and now projected as the weakest starter on the roster. That is not bad luck. That is the draft working as intended. Bo Nix landing at QB15 two-plus rounds early would be forgivable if the manager had gotten value elsewhere, but the well was dry. Christian McCaffrey fell to them at RB3 and they still finished last in the division, which means they caught the one break available and proceeded to waste the rest of the day reaching on players the market had quietly passed over. The Foreskin went 31-5 in 2025. Whatever that team was, this one is not it.

Messick22 posted a 26-10 record last season and promptly celebrated by torching the draft board in 2026. The damage is concentrated where it hurts most: three major reaches, zero steals, and a draft philosophy that seemed less like a strategy and more like organized panic. Jaxson Dart, a QB11, got yanked off the board nearly two full rounds early in round three, a price that would make sense for an established QB1 and makes no sense here. Then, as if to prove the first error wasn't a fluke, the back end of the draft featured Sean Tucker, a RB65, taken more than five rounds ahead of his market value. The top of the roster isn't a disaster, Josh Allen and Drake London anchor things, and the Allen-Moore stack carries real upside. But when your construction depends on late-round depth and you've burned those picks reaching for players like Tucker and Braelon Allen, the floor gets very low, very fast. Eleventh in the division and 22nd percentile tournament-wide is where the math lands, and the math is merciless.

There is not much good news coming out of the aimpai camp as the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl approaches. Sitting 10th in the World of Warcraft division and projecting at just the 31st percentile of the field, this roster is already working from a deficit, and the draft did not generate the surplus value needed to overcome it. Nineteen picks produced zero steals and a single value, while five reaches, including a major one on Fernando Mendoza at QB27 taken more than two rounds early, spent precious capital on a player who grades out as the third quarterback on the roster. The top of the lineup has genuine appeal, with De'Von Achane at RB6, Saquon Barkley at RB8, and Justin Jefferson at WR6 giving aimpai a real ceiling, but beneath that trio the floor drops fast. With C.J. Stroud projecting as QB22 and Cam Ward at QB23 representing the realistic quarterback options, this team needs everything to break right, and the draft gave it very little margin for error.

bolz15 drafted with genuine patience. Sixteen chalk picks and only one minor reach in Greg Dulcich tell you this manager understood price discipline, and the steals on Zach Charbonnet and Michael Pittman, each falling more than two rounds past their ADPs, suggest someone who knew how to wait. The cruelty is that it did not matter. Lamar Jackson projects as QB3, which is legitimately good, and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchors the whole operation. But the roster thins out quickly after those two, and the projected starters include Pittman at WR44 and Dulcich at TE25, both of whom are asking a lot of their manager to carry meaningful weeks. The format rewards depth of quality across the lineup, and bolz15 simply does not have enough of it past the top two. Landing in the 33rd percentile of the field, ninth in the World of Warcraft division, this team looks like a draft that executed the process correctly and still produced the worst possible outcome: a roster that did everything right by the numbers and arrived nowhere in particular.

DynoMC went to the draft with a plan and executed it, landing CeeDee Lamb at 2.03 when his ADP sat at 1.11, which is the kind of thing that makes a manager feel very smart for about four months. The receiver group genuinely glitters, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Lamb at WR5, and five more projected starters behind them. The problem is that a positionless format rewards depth only when that depth converts into points, and the rest of this roster keeps interrupting the party. James Conner checks in at RB56, the tight end situation leans on Brenton Strange at TE17 and Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19 as the projected starters, and Okonkwo is literally the team's weakest projected starter. DynoMC ran the value game correctly, three picks fell past ADP, only one minor reach on the board, zero major mistakes, and the result is a team sitting eighth in the World of Warcraft division at the 49th percentile. Doing everything right and still landing in the middle is the specific cruelty this draft was built to deliver.

FFHitman finished at 73rd percentile in scoring last season and is sitting at 53rd percentile in projections for 2026, which is about as median as a team can get without trying. The margins decide this season, and the margins here are genuinely interesting. Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Trey McBride at TE2 give this roster a legitimate high-end anchor at two positions, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 keeps the floor from caving in. The problem is what happens at the edges. Keenan Allen is a seven-round reach projected at WR99, a gamble that costs draft capital without adding much ceiling, and Jadarian Price, the projected weakest starter at RB26, is the kind of player who wins you weeks when everything breaks right and costs you weeks when it doesn't. FFHitman is not a bottom-feeder and not a contender, sitting seventh in the World of Warcraft division with a roster built just well enough to stay competitive and just inconsistently enough to make every close matchup feel like a coin flip.

There was no lottery ticket moment in this draft, no swinging-for-the-fences gamble that either makes or breaks a season. What svalukis did instead was grind out consistent advantages, and the board reflects it. Puka Nacua, the WR1 in the field, landed at 1.05 when the consensus had him going four spots earlier, a small discount on the biggest name in the draft. Patrick Mahomes slipped a full 1.8 rounds past his ADP and svalukis was right there to take him at 7.05, giving the roster a QB4 in Joe Burrow stacked with Tee Higgins and a perfectly serviceable Mahomes insurance policy underneath. Courtland Sutton fell the same 1.8 rounds and came along for the ride at WR37. None of these are dramatic stories on their own, but that is the point. Five values against zero steals and ten chalk picks paint the picture of a manager who trusted the board and kept winning small, and small wins compound. Sitting sixth in the World of Warcraft division and in the 59th percentile, this roster has the ceiling to do considerably better than that.

CanadianCowboys didn't make a lot of noise on draft day, and that's exactly the point. This roster was built the way a good contractor builds a house: no single flashy choice, just sound decision after sound decision adding up to something sturdy. Bijan Robinson at RB2 anchors the backfield, and the receiving corps runs four projected starters, with Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18) landing as genuine contributors at a discount to their ADPs. Tyler Warren (TE4) was the one spot where CanadianCowboys paid a slight premium, taken a few picks before consensus, but at TE4 the price of admission is easy to justify. The draft sheet reads 14 chalk calls and only one minor reach against a steal in Aaron Rodgers, who fell more than three rounds past his ADP. Last season's 96th-percentile scoring output suggests this manager knows how to convert a roster into points. Sitting fifth in the World of Warcraft division and at the 60th percentile of the field entering 2026, there is real room to climb, and this team looks built to do exactly that.

kies0055 didn't need a miracle pick to build a roster worth respecting in the World of Warcraft division, just a draft that kept finding the right player at the right time. The foundation is as clean as it gets: Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the lineup, Tucker Kraft slots in at TE5, and the two connect through a Jordan Love stack that adds a bonus layer of upside. At receiver, A.J. Brown at WR8 and George Pickens at WR10 give this team two bonafide studs before the position even gets complicated. The quarterback room tells the same story of quiet efficiency, with Justin Herbert landing at pick 4.07 despite carrying a QB8 projection, nearly a full round of free value. That's how this roster was assembled, not through lottery tickets but through consistent, compounding advantages. Sitting at 70th percentile across the field and fourth in the division, kies0055 arrives at the season having outworked the draft board in the ways that matter most.

raptorzz lands at third in the division and the 75th percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly how they got there: quietly, patiently, and almost always correctly. The foundation is a backfield anchored by James Cook, projected RB5, who slid half a round past his ADP and fell right into raptorzz's lap at pick 2.10. Pair that with Jeremiyah Love at RB13 and Kyren Williams at RB15 as fellow projected starters, and the high-end depth here is genuine. At receiver, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Nico Collins at WR9 give the roster two legitimate top-tier options, and Brock Purdy at QB13 came at a discount, taken a full round after his ADP suggested he would. The Calvin Ridley reach is the one moment raptorzz got impatient, taking a WR78 projection three rounds early, but one blemish in a draft that produced three genuine values and only two reaches total is hardly cause for alarm. This roster did not bet the house on one flashy pick. It just kept winning small.

Flossaby didn't win the draft on one big swing. They won it on seven of them. Seven players landed in their lap past their average draft position, and the cumulative edge reads like a masterclass in patience over impulse. Jalen Hurts slid almost a full round, giving Flossaby a QB9 at a QB-low price while Hurts and DeVonta Smith arrive as a connected stack, both projected starters, bought at a discount. Smith himself fell 1.1 rounds, landing at WR3 Jaxon Smith-Njigba's feet as a WR14 who cost fifth-round capital. Terry McLaurin came in 1.4 rounds late and projects as a starter at WR24. Stack those three names together and the receiving corps looks expensive on paper but was assembled cheaply in practice. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 anchor the rest of the lineup with genuine upside. The minor reaches sprinkled through the later rounds are exactly that, minor, and the zero major reaches tells you Flossaby kept their head when other managers were getting sentimental. Second in the World of Warcraft division and 83rd percentile overall, this roster earned both numbers.

MaclandJ didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't gamble on upside and limp home. They just kept winning the moment, pick after pick, and the 94th percentile finish in the field reflects exactly that. The engine here is obvious: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 anchors the whole operation, and the supporting cast behind him was assembled with real patience. Kyle Pitts landed at TE7 after falling nearly two rounds past his ADP, and Travis Kelce, already projected TE10, slid even further before MaclandJ grabbed him at 8.11. That is two top-ten tight ends acquired at a discount, and Harold Fannin at TE6 rounds out a group that quietly represents some of the best value on the entire roster. Six players came in below their ADP against zero steals and zero minor reaches, which tells you something about the discipline at work here. The one blemish, Pat Bryant reached 2.7 rounds early, is the kind of single mistake you can absorb when the rest of the board was this consistently favorable. Division-leading teams are usually built on a moment of genius. This one was built on not making errors.
