As they confront the daunting task of clawing their way up from the 16th percentile overall, a sense of despondency hangs heavily over the turtles, leaving fans bracing for another year of unfulfilled potential and lingering disappointment.

expected, questionable drafting decisions have cast a pall over their potential, notably reaching for Matthew Stafford well ahead of consensus. As the season unfolds, TROUTFINGER will need to harness whatever tactical acumen it can muster to ascend from its current station, lest it be consigned to a season of weary toil in the deep shadows of their competition.




