There is no flattering spin available for 99% Missed, and the draft sheet makes that abundantly clear. In a positionless format where roster quality is everything, this team logged zero steals, zero values, and four major reaches against thirteen chalk picks, which is less a draft strategy than a demonstration of how to pay full price for average outcomes. The headliner reach is Saquon Barkley, taken 1.04 when his ADP sat at 3.02, meaning the manager spent a top-five pick on an RB8 projection and felt good about it. The second-most damaging swing was Malik Nabers at 2.09, a WR12 projection taken nearly a round and a half before the market agreed he was worth it. Spend up twice in the first three rounds, get nothing back in value, and the rest of the draft becomes damage control, which explains why the projected starters bottom out at Chuba Hubbard at RB29. Last season ended at 52nd percentile. This roster is projected last in the division. The arrow is not pointing up.

BrandonBlanco sits 11th in XCOM 2 and in the 11th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The most damning evidence is the quarterback situation: Patrick Mahomes, projected QB12, was yanked off the board nearly three full rounds ahead of his ADP, and Drake Maye, projected QB2, went at 1.03 when his ADP sat a round later. Spending two of the first ten picks on signal-callers at that cost would need to pay off spectacularly, and Maye stacking with A.J. Brown, projected WR8, gives this team its one genuinely exciting axis. Brown's partnership with Maye in New England is legitimately tantalizing, but Brown has missed at least two games in five of his seven seasons, and BrandonBlanco cannot afford that fragility when so many draft capital decisions have already backfired. Five major reaches across the roster, zero steals, and a weakest projected starter in Zach Charbonnet at RB42 paint the picture of a draft that never recovered from its opening moves. There is no charitable read here.

There is not much to celebrate in the XCOM 2 division, and mleutl2 sits at the bottom of it, projecting in just the 16th percentile of the field. The draft tells a lot of the story: three major reaches dot the board, headlined by Kyle Monangai (RB33) grabbed nearly four-and-a-half rounds early and MarShawn Lloyd (RB66) taken almost six rounds ahead of consensus. Those are the kinds of swings that squeeze the oxygen out of a draft. The lone genuine star on the roster is Jonathan Taylor (RB4), and he is doing a lot of load-bearing here. Beyond Taylor, the best the lineup can offer are middling contributors like Tetairoa McMillan (WR15) and Trey McBride (TE2) keeping the floor from caving entirely. Baker Mayfield (QB18) is a question mark, coming off a disappointing 2025 and now without Mike Evans in Tampa Bay, leaving real doubt about whether he can claw back to his 2024 form. This roster has a lever-pulled-too-early feeling, and with no obvious fix in sight, the outlook is bleak.

FatSquirtle sits ninth in the XCOM 2 division and at the 33rd percentile of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The backfield is genuinely excellent, headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and supported by James Cook, Kenneth Walker III, and Jeremiyah Love, all projected starters who give this team a real foundation. The problem is that the rest of the roster reads like a rough draft nobody finished. Chris Brazzell II at WR101 is the lone receiver on the depth chart, and the quarterback room bottoms out at Bryce Young at QB26, with Sam Darnold at QB21 as the nominal best option. In a positionless format where managers field their best players in almost any mix, that means FatSquirtle is leaning entirely on its backfield to carry the scoring load while other teams fill out lineups with quality contributors across the board. A 13-23 record and 23rd-percentile scoring in 2025 suggest this is a pattern, not a fluke, and there is no obvious lever left to pull.

ROV-R finished in the 80th percentile last season, and the roster they've assembled for 2026 projects at just the 47th percentile, which is a long way to fall without visibly tripping. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Brock Bowers at TE1 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 give this team a ceiling that most managers in XCOM 2 can't match, and both were acquired at value relative to ADP. But the drop-off from that top tier is steep and unforgiving. The projected starters thin out fast, with Jayden Reed checking in as the weakest at WR48, and the backfield offers Brian Robinson at RB45 and Braelon Allen at RB58, neither of whom inspires much confidence. What makes the roster harder to defend is the draft process itself: three major reaches, including Theo Johnson and Kayshon Boutte taken four-plus rounds early, suggest the manager was hunting upside that the projections aren't buying. ROV-R has the star power to remind you of last year's team. It doesn't yet have the depth to replicate it.

Pod Popper sits at 62nd percentile and seventh in the division, which is exactly the kind of standing that gets decided by the small stuff. The receiver group is genuinely good, with Puka Nacua (WR1), George Pickens (WR10), Rashee Rice (WR13), and Zay Flowers (WR16) all projecting as starters, and the Dak Prescott-Pickens stack adds a correlation bonus that matters in tight weeks. Prescott, though, was the draft's most visible overpay, taken nearly a full round before his ADP as a QB7, and the Aaron Rodgers (QB29) selection cost three rounds of value on a player barely worth rostering. That's the tension here: the top of this roster earns its keep, but the draft capital spent chasing quarterbacks early could have reinforced the back end instead. Dallas Goedert (TE15) provides a useful floor at a tricky position, a manager who watched Goedert go for four touchdowns in three weeks last fantasy season knows exactly what they're holding. When Pod Popper wins, it's because Nacua and the receivers carry the load and the margins break right. When they don't, those quarterback reaches will be the reason.

dockelley didn't swing for the fences, but round after round this draft quietly came out ahead. The wide receiver group is the engine here: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) give this roster a genuinely elite top end, and Chris Olave (WR11) and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) provide the kind of depth that keeps a lineup dangerous even when things go sideways. At tight end, Colston Loveland (TE3) and Isaiah Likely (TE13) were both allowed to fall past their ADPs before dockelley picked them up, a recurring theme in a draft that logged four values against zero steals, the quiet work of a manager who didn't need luck to find an edge. The Jared Goff and Amon-Ra stack adds a layer of upside that matters in a tournament format, and while Goff's ceiling is legitimately capped by his lack of mobility, Detroit's offense has been too consistently dynamic for that limitation to cost him much weekly. A 63rd percentile projection in a competitive field is not a ceiling, it's a floor to build on.

Luxembourg didn't win the draft with one big swing. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session: quietly, consistently, and mostly without drama. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 anchors the core, Omarion Hampton slots in at RB9, and Chase Brown at RB11 was taken at 4.04 when his ADP sat at 3.08, a clean value that sharpens an already strong group. The ceiling conversation, though, starts with Jaylen Waddle. The Dolphins passing game was a grind to watch last year, but Waddle now lands in Denver alongside Courtland Sutton, where Bo Nix threw more passes than anyone in the league in 2025. A WR23 projection in that offense feels conservative. Lamar Jackson at QB3 keeps the ceiling high, and Travis Kelce at TE10 means there's no soft spot at the position either. Sitting at 64th percentile with a 24-12 record from a year ago as context, Luxembourg looks like a team that came into 2026 knowing exactly what they were doing.

skolpoplife didn't force anything in this draft, and the roster reflects it. The foundation starts with Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, two projected starters who give this team a ceiling most managers would envy. From there, it's about the accumulation of quiet advantages. Harold Fannin fell 1.3 rounds past his ADP before skolpoplife scooped him up at TE6, and Mark Andrews slid nearly two full rounds before landing at TE14, meaning the team locked up a starter-quality tight end and a credible backup at below-market prices. Even Trevor Lawrence, sometimes more promise than production, showed last year that the breakthrough was real, posting a 4,000-yard season and carrying a career high in rushing touchdowns, which adds a layer of upside to a QB situation that projects Lawrence at QB10 alongside Jalen Hurts at QB9. Sitting 77th percentile in the field and fourth in XCOM 2, this is a team built not on one flashy swing but on a draft that kept winning the small moments, and those add up.

LeonsRequiem finished 2025 in the 74th percentile and somehow came back and built something better, landing in the 81st percentile for 2026 with a draft that reads less like a gamble and more like a steady accumulation of correct answers. The foundation starts at QB1 Josh Allen at the top of the board, a minor reach at 1.01 against an ADP of 1.05 that barely qualifies as one, and the value came in waves behind him. Kyle Pitts fell nearly a round and a half to 7.01, Dalton Kincaid tumbled over a round to 9.01, and those two form a legitimate stack with Allen that adds a secondary current running through the offense. Alec Pierce slid more than a round to round 8, Nico Collins projects as WR9, and DeVonta Smith sits at WR14 as a projected starter. Six values across the roster against zero major reaches is not luck, it is execution, and LeonsRequiem lands third in the division with a case that the gap to first is smaller than that number implies.

SirMileHighness didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a consistent eye for value. The clearest example is Ja'Marr Chase, the WR2 in the field, landed at pick 1.07 despite an ADP of 1.02, a near-miss that still represents a win at that price. Drake London, a projected WR7 and a starter, fell more than a full round past his ADP into the third. Then there's the backfield, where Derrick Henry (RB12), Breece Hall (RB14), and Josh Jacobs (RB16) form a projected starting core that most managers would mortgage later rounds to acquire. David Montgomery adds a quietly interesting wrinkle: after his carries dried up in Detroit, he signed with Houston to compete for the top job, and if he takes that backfield, his RB23 projection starts to look conservative. The one blemish is the early commitment to Caleb Williams, a round ahead of his ADP, but Williams projects as QB6, so the reach at least landed on a real asset. Second in the division and 87th percentile overall, SirMileHighness drafted like a team that already knew where it was going.

Sitting atop XCOM 2 and nestled in the 98th percentile of the entire field, pcosores did not stumble into this position. This is a roster assembled with intention. The draft board tells the story cleanly: two steals, three values, and fourteen chalk picks, with only one meaningful reach blemishing an otherwise surgical process. Joe Burrow at QB4 anchors a passing-game core that includes Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Tyler Warren at TE4, both of whom pcosores landed a full round past their ADP. Then George Kittle at TE9 and Oronde Gadsden at TE16 fell more than two rounds each into waiting hands, the kind of draft-day gravity that separates disciplined managers from opportunistic ones. De'Von Achane at RB6 adds another layer of projected starter value secured below market. Quinshon Judkins, recovering from a late-season fractured fibula and reportedly on track for training camp, gives this team a meaningful depth piece with upside if his health holds. The weakest projected starter is Michael Wilson at WR39. In most fields, that is a problem. Here, it reads like a floor.
