There is no charitable read available for TLandFlurrySports, and the draft log is not going to offer one. The team sits second percentile in the Yoshi division, and the construction explains why: this roster is built almost entirely around tight ends, which is fine in a positionless format until you notice that the manager paid a steep premium to get there. Tyler Warren was taken nearly a full round early. Harold Fannin cost almost two rounds of surplus. Kenyon Sadiq, projected TE21, was drafted nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP. Michael Mayer, projected TE39, was taken nearly five rounds ahead of his. That is not a draft strategy so much as a compulsion, and the cost shows up everywhere else. The WR group tops out at Jalen Coker at WR55, with the next five names ranging from WR61 to WR98. The lone steal on the board was Oronde Gadsden at TE16, which at this point reads less like savvy and more like the universe throwing the manager a sympathy card they absolutely did not deserve.

TheSeigeDFS walked into the Scott Fish Bowl and reached on three players before the draft even had time to feel the consequences. Fernando Mendoza, taken nearly six rounds before his ADP, is a QB27 with no path to fantasy relevance. Terrance Ferguson, grabbed over three rounds early, is a TE28. Those two picks alone would have been enough to sink most rosters, but TheSeigeDFS made sure to confirm the pattern by also reaching on Davante Adams, who lands as a WR25, a number that does not justify the premium paid. The rest of the draft produced zero steals and zero values, just fourteen chalk picks and a prayer. Ja'Marr Chase and Nico Collins are legitimately good, and there is real talent scattered across the projected starters, but this is a team projected 11th in the Yoshi division and in the 13th percentile of the field, and nothing in the draft history suggests the manager found a hidden edge anywhere. Some teams get unlucky. TheSeigeDFS just reached.

KatieMest enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Yoshi division and in just the 20th percentile of the field, and the roster offers very little reason for optimism. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine star, and the team leaned into that asset, but the supporting cast grades out thin in ways that compound quickly. The receiver group tops out at Chris Olave at WR11, which is serviceable, and then drops off sharply to D.J. Moore at WR26 and DK Metcalf at WR36. The tight end situation is quietly brutal, with Colby Parkinson projected at TE31 and Mason Taylor at TE35, neither of whom moves the needle in a positionless format where replacement-level production at any spot costs you. Perhaps most telling is the David Montgomery situation: brought aboard presumably to add depth behind McCaffrey, Montgomery arrives in Houston now competing with Woody Marks for touches on a new team, his role murkier than his fantasy managers would like. This roster had a 39 percent win rate in 2025, and nothing in the 2026 construction suggests the trajectory is bending upward.

Last year aysolis finished in the 96th percentile, so the instinct is to trust the name. The numbers say to resist that instinct. The team sits at the 32nd percentile in tournament projections and ninth in the Yoshi division, and the roster explains why. The tight end group headlined by Brock Bowers at TE1 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 is genuinely excellent, and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 gives the team a cornerstone. But the wide receiver corps collapses fast, with Josh Downs projected at WR46 as the weakest projected starter, and the depth behind him, Jayden Higgins at WR54, Denzel Boston at WR58, and beyond, reads like a list of best-case scenarios rather than reliable contributors. The draft did not patch this, producing zero steals and two major reaches in Zachariah Branch and Tyquan Thornton, both taken well before their ADPs and both projecting outside the top 90 at their position. Ninety-sixth percentile is a credential, not a roster, and this one has a long way to go to honor it.

MattJudd12 did everything right and arrived somewhere wrong anyway. The draft was a model of patience, picking up Blake Corum a round and a half past his ADP, Dallas Goedert a full round late, and Chuba Hubbard later still, with barely a reach anywhere on the board. Fifteen chalk picks and three genuine values, zero major reaches. The process was clean. The roster landed at 33rd percentile. That gap between method and outcome is the specific kind of punishment that makes fantasy football feel like a long con. The backfield group is legitimately deep, with Chase Brown, Derrick Henry, Josh Jacobs, and Javonte Williams all projecting as starters, and Drake Maye arriving with a new weapon in AJ Brown that should make him a genuine asset at QB2. But the receiver group thins out fast, with Rome Odunze and Marvin Harrison Jr. projecting at WR30 and WR33 respectively and the third projected starter, Jayden Reed, sitting at WR48. MattJudd12 valued the process, and the process smiled back, and the standings in the Yoshi division still have this team sitting eighth.

Mark Andrews falling a round past his ADP is a nice find, but one value pick does not fix what ails this roster. @MGutierrezNFL sits seventh in the Yoshi division and at just the 34th tournament percentile, and the draft did little to change the trajectory, producing zero steals against three major reaches, including Skyler Bell taken nearly seven rounds ahead of his ADP at WR103. The wide receiver group is legitimately impressive on paper, with Justin Jefferson, A.J. Brown, and Rashee Rice all projected starters, and the Brown move to New England alongside Drake Maye carries real upside. But Brown has missed at least two games in five of his seven seasons, and a team already projected this thin can ill afford to absorb that kind of variance. With Khalil Shakir grading out as the weakest projected starter at WR51, the ceiling here depends almost entirely on the top of the roster staying healthy, and that is a fragile foundation to build a tournament run on.

mmoon335 enters 2026 as the Yoshi division's most frustratingly average squad, sitting sixth in the division and at the 42nd tournament percentile, which is exactly as middling as it sounds. The ceiling is real: Josh Allen at QB1 paired with Jayden Daniels at QB5 gives this roster two elite options at the position, and the Daniels/Terry McLaurin stack adds a correlated bonus that could spike a big week when everything connects. Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchors the skill players, and Tee Higgins at WR19 provides a credible second weapon. But the floor matters just as much here, and that's where the margins get uncomfortable. The draft skewed heavily toward chalk, with just two values and a major reach on Hunter Henry's backup, Theo Johnson, taken nearly three and a half rounds early at TE37. Last year's 90th-percentile scoring pace won't carry over on pedigree alone. In a season decided by small edges, mmoon335 has enough talent to beat anyone on a given week and just enough fragility to lose to nearly anyone too.

kooks13 didn't build this roster with one bold swing, just a series of smart decisions that quietly added up to something worth watching in the Yoshi division. The clearest example is Malik Nabers, a WR12 projection taken more than a round and a half after his average draft position suggested he'd be gone, which is the kind of find that separates a good draft from a great one. Around him, kooks13 layered in Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, DeVonta Smith at WR14, and Zay Flowers at WR16, the last of whom was the one place on the roster where kooks13 paid a slight premium, taking Flowers about a round early. That willingness to reach modestly for a player you believe in, while staying disciplined almost everywhere else, is a sign of a manager with conviction rather than stubbornness. The 2025 campaign finished at the 98th percentile in scoring, so the baseline here is proven. Sitting at the 74th percentile heading into 2026, kooks13 looks like a team that consistently drafts ahead of the curve.

DynastyIsland sits at 79th percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why: this roster was built round by round through patient accumulation rather than any single headline move. The top of the lineup is legitimately elite, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 projecting as two of the best starters in the entire tournament, while Justin Herbert at QB8 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 give the team two premium passers to choose from each week. What makes the draft tick, though, is the value layer underneath. Carnell Tate fell a full round past his ADP and lands as a projected starter at WR29, and Kyler Murray slipped nearly two rounds to become the QB19 on this roster. That kind of consistent buying power is hard to manufacture. The two late-round reaches on Jack Bech and Dontayvion Wicks are worth noting, but at picks 17 and 18 the downside is limited. DynastyIsland did not force anything, and the standings at draft close reflect it.

fastfreddy88 lands at 84th percentile in the field and third in the Yoshi Division, and the draft tells you exactly why: not a single dramatic swing, just round after round of sensible acquisition. The engine here is a running back group that reads like a depth chart built for chaos, anchored by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5, both projected starters, with Ashton Jeanty slotting in at RB7. Cook is the one mild ADP story worth mentioning, sliding half a round past his number at 2.10, a small edge that compounds over a full season. The weakest projected starter is Kyle Monangai at RB33, which tells you something about the floor this team is operating from. Bo Nix rounds out the quarterback room as a projected QB15, a back-end-of-the-top-fifteen option who has led the league in pass attempts and now has Jaylen Waddle added to his arsenal. The ceiling question for Nix is real, but for a team already sitting at 84th percentile, it is a luxury problem.

chelsiep didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. This team was built pick by pick, and the cumulative result lands them in the 87th percentile of the field and second in the Yoshi Division. The foundation is real: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, Colston Loveland sits at TE3, and Tucker Kraft comes in right behind him at TE5. Kraft missed time with a November ACL injury last season, but he came off the preseason PUP list before August and returns to a Packers offense that shed receivers rather than added them, which points toward a workload similar to the one that had him briefly operating as a legitimate star. Loveland at TE3 alongside him is the kind of pairing that quietly wins weeks. Layered underneath all of this is a backfield group anchored by Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Travis Etienne at RB18, both projected starters. chelsiep finished 2025 at 83rd percentile in scoring. The arrow is pointing the same direction in 2026.

Typhicane enters 2026 sitting in first place in the Yoshi division, 97th percentile in the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs, the RB1 overall, snagged at 1.08 when his ADP sat at 1.03, a small gap that still signals a manager who knew what he wanted and went and got it. From there, the value compounds: Joe Burrow at QB4 slipped a full round and a fifth past his ADP, Trevor Lawrence at QB10 fell even further, and Quentin Johnston at WR41 is the steal of the sheet, tumbling more than two full rounds to land at 11.08. Fifteen chalk picks round out a roster that was built with patience and precision, not desperation. The weakest projected starter is Johnston, which means this team's floor is quietly higher than most managers' ceilings. One minor reach on Ja'Kobi Lane in the eighteenth round is the only blemish on what is otherwise a masterclass in reading a board and trusting it.
