deutschmat sits dead last in the You Don't Know Jack division and in the 1st percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains why: six major reaches against zero steals, a transaction history that reads less like a strategy and more like a series of panicked guesses. The most damaging wound came early. Tyler Shough, a QB20 projection, went off the board in round three, a full five rounds before his ADP, at a moment in the draft when genuine difference-makers were still available. Then, as if to double down on the philosophy, Kyle Monangai, a RB33, got plucked in round seven despite an ADP that placed him squarely in round twelve. Chimere Dike, a WR84, cost a round-twelve pick that arrived seven rounds ahead of schedule. The net result is a roster anchored by De'Von Achane and Drake Maye that deserved better architecture around it. Achane and Maye did not lose this team the season. The draft did.

There is no spin available for sleepercecily, just a draft sheet that reads like a series of increasingly regrettable decisions. The most glaring: Sam Darnold, a QB21 projection, eaten up with a fourth-round pick, more than five rounds before the market ever intended. That is not a calculated gamble on upside, that is a reach so severe it distorts the entire draft, costing this roster real value at positions where good players were still available. Then, apparently unconvinced that one TE reach was enough, sleepercecily went back and grabbed Hunter Henry at pick 8.01 despite Henry projecting as a TE18, then doubled down in the late rounds with Darnell Washington and Michael Mayer, both taken more than four rounds early, both projecting outside the top 35 at their position. The one moment of genuine draft intelligence, landing Chigoziem Okonkwo past his ADP, barely registers against the surrounding carnage. The 2025 squad finished in the 33rd percentile and this roster, sitting 11th in its division and projected in the 13th percentile of the field, suggests the trajectory is not improving.

There is no easy fix available for Bud3, and the draft did not generate one. Sitting 10th in the You Don't Know Jack division and projecting at just the 28th percentile of the field, this roster has a clear identity problem: the receiver group is genuinely strong, anchored by Justin Jefferson (WR6) and DeVonta Smith (WR14) and extended through Luther Burden (WR22) and Christian Watson (WR28), but the players distributing the ball to them are a significant drag. Jordan Love (QB17) and Kyler Murray (QB19) grade out as middling starters, and Fernando Mendoza sits at QB27. The draft did little to correct the imbalance, logging two major reaches in Ray Davis (RB62) and Jayden Higgins (WR54), both taken well ahead of consensus, with zero steals to show for the aggression. Ashton Jeanty (RB7) and Omarion Hampton (RB9) give the roster a pulse, but when your weakest projected starter is Higgins and your quarterback room is this thin on upside, you are essentially hoping everything breaks right at once. Nothing in this draft suggests Bud3 has earned that kind of luck.

Rjw615 did almost everything right on draft day. Of the roster's 19 picks, 16 came at or after ADP, including legitimate late-round finds like Zach Charbonnet sliding to 16.12 and Tucker Kraft landing as a projected TE5. The problem is that doing everything right still landed this team at 42nd percentile and ninth in the You Don't Know Jack division, which is the specific kind of outcome that makes fantasy players question their life choices. The receiver group is the quiet culprit. Alec Pierce, Michael Pittman, and Wan'Dale Robinson project as the likely starters at WR32, WR44, and WR47 respectively, and however much value Pierce represented falling to 9.01, value at a middling projection is still a middling projection. Tyreek Hill at WR77 is not the Hill anyone remembers. Rjw615 played the market correctly and still assembled a roster that ranks outside the top half of the field, proof that ADP efficiency is a process measure, not a results guarantee.

Tweaker2 sits eighth in the You Don't Know Jack division and barely cracks the tournament's median at the 48th percentile, and the draft log does not offer much hope that better days are coming. The roster leans on Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) and Jalen Hurts (QB9) as its anchors, but after those two the drop-off is real and the path forward is murky. Hurts was taken a minor reach at 3.03, and Cam Ward landed two full rounds early at QB23, meaning the draft capital spent securing quarterback depth came at a premium that did not exactly pay dividends. The single major reach of the draft, Nicholas Singleton at RB57, sits near the bottom of the projected field and offers little comfort. The two values the team did land, Jadarian Price and Isaiah Likely, are fine late-round finds, but Price projects as the weakest starter on the roster at RB26, which tells you everything about what those bargains are worth. This roster has the look of a team that drafted carefully enough to avoid disaster yet not boldly enough to manufacture upside.

Smoot To Win sits at 50th percentile in the field, and that number feels exactly right, which is either reassuring or quietly terrifying depending on your disposition. The ceiling case starts with Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 who needs no explanation, and Jayden Daniels, a QB5 whose stack with Terry McLaurin gives this roster a legitimate points-explosion mechanism on any given week. The floor case is where things get uncomfortable. Malik Nabers is the swing variable nobody can fully price: a WR12 projection attached to a knee that Harbaugh himself called "not simple," and an ACL recovery that had dynasty managers sweating through a celebrity softball game. If Nabers is fully himself by September, this roster has the kind of top-end punch that quietly beats teams who underestimated it. If he labors through a second straight shortened season, Chase and Daniels are carrying heavier weight than anyone projected. Smoot To Win drafted almost entirely to consensus, 17 chalk picks against just one value, so there is no hidden upside buried in the later rounds. The margins, in every direction, decide this.

The Atlantic Salmonators are a team you respect but don't fear, which is precisely the kind of team that either sneaks into something meaningful or quietly disappears at 52nd percentile. The margins are everywhere here. On the bright side, the top of this roster is genuinely good: CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 give the Salmonators a ceiling that can compete with anyone on a given week. The draft was mostly chalk, but Taylor falling to pick 2.05 despite an ADP of 2.01 and Colston Loveland sliding a full round to become a TE3 starter are exactly the kind of quiet advantages that separate 52nd percentile from 65th by November. The concern is the floor. Xavier Worthy projects as the weakest projected starter at WR49, and in a positionless format where lineup decisions are everything, the weeks Worthy gets the call over someone else could be the difference between a winning record and a quietly frustrating one. This roster does not lose the draft. Whether it wins the season depends on whether those margins fall the right way.

sheriffwoody1993 finished last season at 52nd percentile in scoring and is projected to land at the 70th percentile in 2026, which is a real jump, and the draft is the reason why. The board says this was not a careful operation: two major reaches, three minor reaches, and exactly zero steals across the whole draft. And yet the roster that came out the other end features Drake London at WR7, Brock Bowers at TE1, and Tyler Warren at TE4, all projected starters, alongside Garrett Wilson at WR17 and Zay Flowers at WR16. The major reaches, Ted Hurst at WR85 and Skyler Bell at WR103, are the part that makes you squint. Hurst was taken 2.8 rounds early, Bell a staggering 6.3 rounds before his ADP, and neither projects as a starter. Those picks cost real draft capital. The honest answer is that sheriffwoody1993 either saw something everyone else missed in the back half of the draft, or spent late

rounds chasing names while the front half carried the weight. For now, the front half is good enough that it almost does not matter.

Last year Gregg Sussman finished with a 1-35 record and scored in the third percentile of the entire field, the kind of season that makes a manager question their life choices. The 2026 roster reads like a direct response to that misery. Joe Burrow, projected QB4, anchors a starting core that also includes Puka Nacua at WR1, and that top-end talent alone separates this team from whatever catastrophe 2025 was. The draft process added to the momentum: Chase Brown came off the board a full round past his ADP, and Chuba Hubbard slid nearly two rounds before Sussman scooped him up, giving this roster a real foundation of value below the first few picks. Sitting at the 75th percentile of the field and fourth in the You Don't Know Jack division, Sussman is not just improved, he is legitimately competitive. One year removed from the basement, this team looks less like a rebuilding project and more like a manager who learned exactly what went wrong and fixed it.

BigBadBarnum is not building a house of cards here, they are building a house of mirrors, and every reflection points back to the same coordinated vision: stack the correlations and let the ceiling take care of itself. The architecture is unmistakable. Josh Allen sits at QB1 and connects to both D.J. Moore at WR26 and Dalton Kincaid at TE11, meaning when Buffalo goes off, BigBadBarnum goes off in triplicate. Layer in Caleb Williams at QB6 paired with Rome Odunze at WR30, and this roster has not one but two loaded guns pointed at the same scoreboard. What makes the construction more impressive is the patience behind it. Olave fell more than a round past his ADP, Kincaid fell a full round, and Cook landed at RB5 for less than market value, meaning BigBadBarnum collected premium correlation pieces without overpaying for the privilege. Sitting third in the division and in the 82nd percentile of the field, this team does not need luck. It needs Josh Allen to decide he wants to win a charity tournament.

BGTL didn't make any single move that will dominate highlight reels, but sit with the draft results for a minute and a pattern emerges: this team consistently got players later than it should have. Derrick Henry at RB12 slipped a round and a half past his ADP, Nico Collins landed at WR3 nearly a full round after the market said he'd be gone, and George Kittle came off the board at TE9 a full round after his price. Four values and twelve chalk picks add up to a roster sitting at the 94th percentile of the entire field, second in the You Don't Know Jack division, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba, A.J. Brown, Collins, and Rashee Rice all projecting as starters. The two major reaches, Tory Horton and Colby Parkinson, are late-round fliers unlikely to define the season either way. What defines it is a draft where BGTL just kept winning small, and those small wins compounded into something worth taking seriously.

gardner37 didn't swing for the fences and miss, or load up on upside plays that blew up at confirmation. This roster got built the way good ones usually do: round after round of coming out slightly ahead. Trey McBride, projected TE2, slid half a round past his ADP and landed at 2.02. Saquon Barkley, projected RB8, fell nearly a full round before gardner37 scooped him at 3.11. Ladd McConkey, projected WR20, drifted more than a round past his number and still ended up in the starting lineup. Three values in a single draft won't make headlines, but they compound, and this roster is sitting at 97th percentile in the field and first in the You Don't Know Jack division because of exactly that kind of accumulation. The foundation underneath those finds is Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Breece Hall at RB14, giving this team a starting core that is already hard to beat before the value picks even factor in. gardner37 built something worth watching.
